THE ORIGINAL FANTASY FUDGE RECIPE

3 cups white sugar

3/4 cup margarine

2/3 cup evaporated milk

1 (12 oz) bag semisweet chocolate chips

1 (7 oz) jar marshmallow crème

1 cup chopped walnuts

1 tsp vanilla extract



Grease a 9 x 13 inch pan.

Mix sugar, margarine and evaporated milk in a saucepan over medium heat, stirring to dissolve sugar.

Bring mixture to a full boil and cook for 5 minutes stirring constantly.

Remove from the heat and add chocolate chips; stir until chips are melted and mixture is thorough combined. Stir in marshmallow crème until incorporated. Mix in walnuts and vanilla.

Transfer fudge to the prepared pan and use an offset spatula to spread out and flatten. Let cool for at least 1 hour before cutting into squares.


