



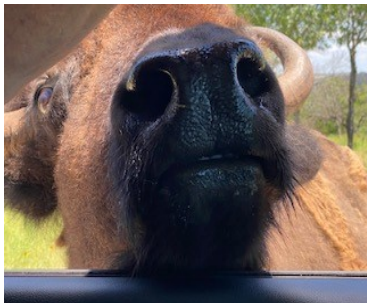

After the meeting was Tech Talk where those who choose meet and discuss issues they are having with their coaches. Other members offer advice and support.

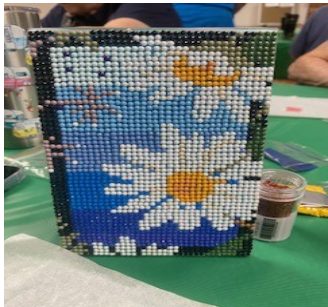


The incredible wagonmaster team included Suzy & Craig Barham, Gary & Linda Swindle, Angel & Ron Canevari & Rhonda & David Layman.

**Saturday night** was pulled pork sandwiches with sides and an ice cream bar for dessert. We were all too busy eating to remember to take a picture.

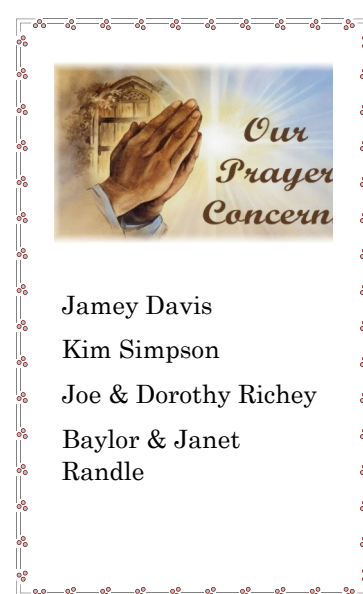
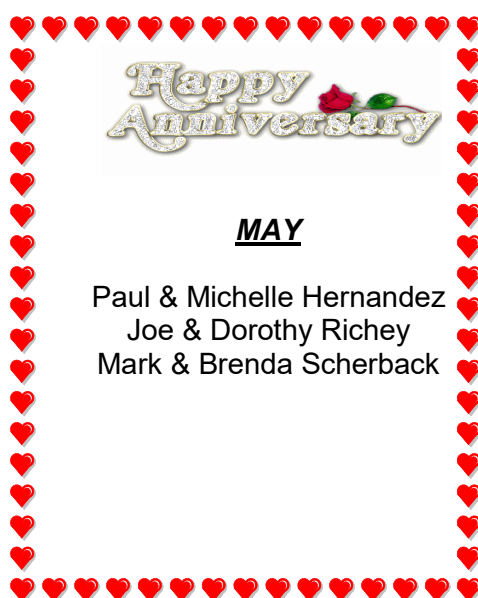

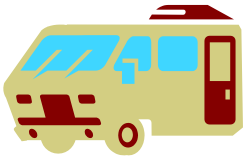
