with some actual winter weather with strong winds and freezing rain on Monday.

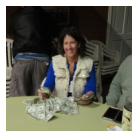
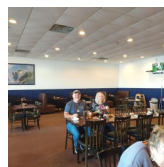
Tuesday it was still cold and some rain but the die hard early arrivals managed to make it to Billy Gene's for dinner.

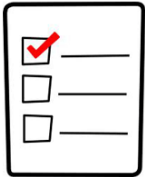

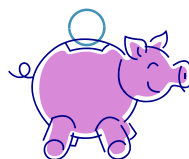
