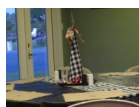

was won by a visitor, Curtis Price, who later thanked us by becoming a member.



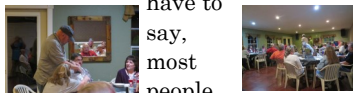

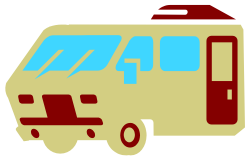

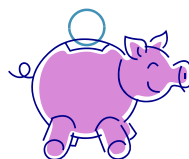
