Saturday morning started with a business meeting with donuts and coffee. New officers were elected for 2023. Thank you all for serving our chapter.


Saturday afternoon we met for games and ice cream in the rally hall. Dean Cockrill won 7-Up and David Layman won Texas Hold Em Poker.
