Saturday morning saw a very filling spread pancakes (with fruit toppings available) sausage & bacon and of course coffee and juice.

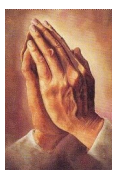
Due to not having a quorum of at least 15 coaches we were unable to have a business meeting. We did

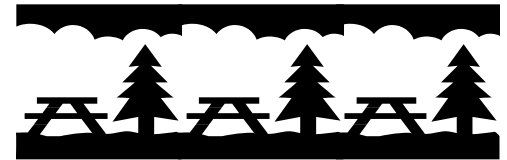

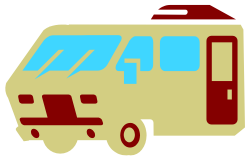

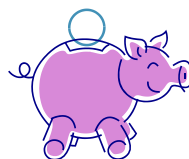
